

## Guidance for PhD Students

Alongside your PhD research in the lab, MCRC places strong emphasis on your personal and professional development. This programme has been designed to introduce you to a wide range of opportunities across our partner institutions:

- MCRC-led opportunities shown in bold Red
- University of Manchester (UoM) highlighted in purple
- The Christie Education Fellow activities highlighted in blue
- CRUK Manchester Institute highlighted in green
- Wellbeing activities-highlighted in pink

Together, these opportunities give you the chance to plan your year ahead and build skills that will support both your research and your future career.

We recommend that you dedicate 2–3 hours every two weeks to personal development training. This is a guideline rather than a strict requirement — you may need to adapt it to suit your own pace and priorities. That flexibility is exactly why this programme has been designed: to allow you to engage with training at a rhythm that works for you, while ensuring you gain the full benefit of the resources available.

## Important notes:

- 1.Please note that the MCRC bespoke curriculum sessions (bold black) are mandatory for CRUK-funded PhDs. You must attend at least one of these sessions, held annually, during your PhD journey before graduation.
- 2. Please also ensure you plan for any <u>mandatory trainings required by your supervisory team</u>, as these form an essential part of your development pathway.
